Take Heed That No Man Deceive You

In our Lord's famous Olivet discourse he warns of the danger of deception. In fact our Lord says there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, who shall show great signs and wonders. The coming deception predicted by our Lord is of such character that if it were possible the very elect would be deceived (Matt. 24:4, 24).

The deception that has troubled our world during the entire church age will only intensify as we approach the end of the age.

The immediate question that arises is how should genuine believers react to the threat of deception? The Apostle Paul gives us the answer in the book of Romans. He says,

"Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them. For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple" (Rom. 16:17,18).

To avoid deception we must separate from false teachers and embrace the doctrine of Christ (2 John 9). The doctrine of which we speak concerns the person and work of our Lord Jesus Christ. We confess that Jesus is God come in the flesh for our salvation. Furthermore, we confess his all sufficient sacrifice on the cross is God's provision for our salvation. We must stand for and proclaim these truths lest we be moved away from the hope of the gospel (Col. 1:23).

In these days of rising deception I pray the Lord grants us grace to faithfully proclaim the truth as it is in Jesus. Amen! May God bless you.
